The Giving Fund appeals to Tahoe Donner members twice a year to support scholarships and grant-making activities. In July, we held our annual dinner and silent auction, which raised \$26,630. Now, at the end of the year, we ask everyone to contribute to our Annual Fund.

Last year, the annual appeal garnered \$31,175 from 99 members (.02%). We have set a goal this year of raising \$62,000 to double last year's contributions. Members of the Tahoe Donner Board of Directors have made their contribution - please consider joining them.

We have a little over 6,000 properties in Tahoe Donner. If each owner contributed to the Giving Fund, we could do so much good for the community that surrounds Tahoe Donner. Please be among those who contribute.

The Giving Fund is run solely by a volunteer committee. Interest and dividends cover TTCF administrative fees. Thus, 100% of each donation goes directly to grants and scholarships. Please help us provide an even greater impact in 2020 by making a gift to the Tahoe Donner Giving Fund.

Return the donation card (coming soon in the annual assessment mailing) with your check.

GIVE FROM YOUR IRA

Make a charitable donation as an IRA Required Minimum Distribution (RMA) by December 31 if you are at least age 70 ½. Instruct your financial institution to send the check to:

Be sure your financial institution includes your name on the transmittal. As an affiliate fund of the

Truckee Tahoe Community Foundation (TTCF) we are under their EIN (68-0416404). For charitable donations made via RMA, the amount of the gift may be subtracted from income tax liability.

GIVE FROM YOUR DONOR ADVISED FUND

If you have a Donor Advised Fund, you may direct the fund's custodian to make a contribution to the Giving Fund. Make sure your name is included in the transmittal information.

GIVE OTHER ASSETS

The Giving Fund, through TTCF, can also receive other assets such as stocks and bonds. Donors may have the opportunity to claim a tax deduction on the item's increased value without capital gains taxes. Consult your tax adviser.
